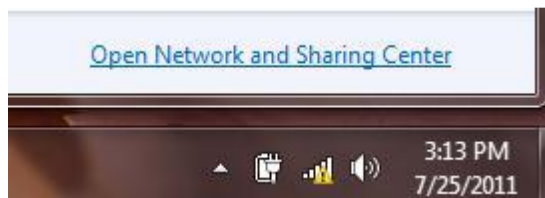


Students are welcome to bring their personal computers to school; however, there is a procedure to get access to the wireless network on campus.

For PC users:

1. First, click the network connection icon on the toolbar in the bottom right of the screen.



2. Next, select the "NYA_Student" network, then click "Connect".



3. Now open your internet browser. You should be redirected to a login page. Simply enter your NYA username and password, then click “Submit”.

Follow a similar process as above. First, turn on your Airport. Next, select the “NYA_Student” wireless from the drop down list. Once Connected, open your internet browser and enter your NYA username and password into the page that appears. Once you click “Submit” you should be connected to the NYA wireless.
