Richard D. Samuelson was a member of the class of 1966 and participated in soccer, basketball, and baseball at North Yarmouth Academy. While only attending NYA for one year he was a celebrated three sport varsity athlete and highly respected by the members of his class and NYA faculty.

He excelled in athletics, as leading hitter on the baseball team and a
