

# The 1930 -1931 NYA Girls Basketball Team

The 1930-31 girls basketball team was the first girls team to represent NYA in interscholastic athletic competition. Playing in Cutter Gymnasium, a wing of the newly opened Curtis Building, they were also one of the first teams to wear the orange and black. Known for their clean play, good sportsmanship and fierce competitive spirit, these girls brought distinction to North Yarmouth Academy while setting a tone that echoes through the halls and across the playing fields to this day. The following year, the student body tripled in size with the addition of all of Yarmouth's high school students. Led by four returners from this 1930-31 team and coached by Pauline Julia Colesworthy and Myron Leighton, this second year squad went 9-4 and finished second in the Triple C League.
