Your summer assignment is to complete the pages of this journal on various days throughout the summer. There are **three parts** to your summer reading assignment:

1. Beginning in or around the first week of July, write **one journal entry a week for 10 weeks.**
2. At some point during the summer, expose yourself to some Hispanic language and culture by watching a film or play and writing, *in English*, a summary and reaction to the event in your journal. (See page 11.)
3. Complete the **ejercicios**, (exercises), at the end of the journal. The intent is to review, and refresh your grammar and vocabulary before classes start—this is the *only* part that you should leave until the last few days before school begins. You will need to look up some verb conjugations and vocabulary words. (See pages 14 and 15.)
