Firstly: Please create a Word document or a PowerPoint with the title "Summer Assignment 23 – Spanish 2 – YOUR NAME" (this will be where you store ALL of your summer work to submit to me)

Secondly: You are NEVER allowed to use a translator nor should you be translating whole sentences. You are, however, allowed to use wordreference.com or a dictionary to look up words as you need. Keep in mind, I want to see YOUR writing and how YOU use the language. I am not looking for perfection, here, just effort.

Tasks:

1. Verb practices (verbs are VERY important!)
 - a. Throughout the summer you should complete one quiz for each of the following verb topics
 - i. To get to the quizzes – go to studyspanish.com, click on "verb drills" at the top, then select the verb topics listed below from the menus on the left
 - ii. Once you have selected the verb topic, click on "generate unique quiz", change the number to 25, and select NO for "vosotros"
 - iii. **Each quiz should be 25 questions**
 - iv. **You must score at LEAST a 95%**
 - v. **If you do not score a 95%, create/complete new quizzes until you do**
 - vi. Once you have gotten at least a 95%, screenshot the results (example below – be sure the screenshot includes the title of the verb topic, your score, and any you answered incorrectly) and save it in your document
